

Travelling by public transport from Zurich Airport

Zurich Airport is excellently linked to public transport. The SBB travel centre is located below the Airport Center in the Check-in 3 area. The ticket counters are open from 06:15 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. Tickets for trains, trams and buses can be purchased at the SBB ticket machines (also located in Arrival 1 and 2), the SBB ticket counters, the Service Center, the switzerlandinfo+ counters or conveniently on the Internet or via smartphone (www.sbb.ch/abos-billette/e-tickets).

From Zurich Airport it only takes about 10 minutes by train to reach Zurich Central Station with more than ten connections per hour.

Travelling by public transport from Zurich Central Station

From the “Bahnhofstrasse/HB” stop:

Tram no. 6 (towards the Zoo) as far as the “ETH/Universitätsspital” stop. Journey time: approx. 6 minutes

From the “Bahnhofplatz/HB” stop:

Tram no. 10 (towards the Airport or Oerlikon station) as far as the “ETH/Universitätsspital” stop or

Tram Nr. 3 (towards Klusplatz) as far as the “Central” stop (1 stop), from “Central” by Polybahn (departs every three minutes) to the Polyterrasse. Journey time: approx. 8 minutes

You will require a ticket that is valid for zone 110 (city of Zurich).
